EURASTiP – The Basics:

- > A three year support action
- Funded through the <u>EU Horizon 2020 programme</u>
- Developed in response to EU call <u>H2020 SFS-24-2016</u> "reinforcing international cooperation on sustainable aquaculture production with countries from South East Asia" (c.f. previous EATiP engagement)
- ➤ €2 Million total budget









- ➤ Evaluate and prepare for the launch of an international multi-stakeholder platform for sustainable aquaculture EURASTiP
 - ☐ Create and reinforce international cooperation on sustainable aquaculture between Europe and SE Asia
 - ☐ Composed of stakeholders from Europe and SE Asia
 - □ Focus on actions that provide mutual benefit to **both** regions i.e. European interests as well as SE Asia.

Specific Objectives (1)



- Create & support National Pilot Multi-Stakeholder Platforms in Thailand, Vietnam & Bangladesh
 - ☐ Focal points for creating links between European and Asian aquaculture "value chains"
 - ☐ Pilot MSPs will be used to develop roadmaps for other MSPs in SE Asia
 - ☐ Become the foundations for the creation of EURASTIP
 - ☐ Key role of "legacy"



Specific Objectives (2)



- Develop the networks needed for the promotion of industrial partnerships
 - ☐ Using European and Asian networks *focussing on*EATIP Mirror Platforms to identify business opportunities, knowledge transfer and areas of collaboration within the value chain
 - Support and facilitate contacts and networking
 - ☐ Organise brokerage events
 - ☐ Promote uptake of innovation by industry / research



Specific Objectives (3)



- Common standards for planning and operation of sustainable aquaculture
 - ☐ Alignment of European and Asian training programmes
 - ➤ Site planning and zoning / spatial planning
 - >Animal Health and Welfare
 - > Food product safety
 - > Farming governance

- Reinforce professional skills in industry and research arenas
 - ☐ Alignment of European and Asian training programmes
 - ☐ Provide industrial apprenticeship opportunities
 - ☐ Develop an international education/training network
 - Mirror Platforms perform a key role in establishing relevant opportunities

Observations: 1

- > EATiP was created as a top-down measure
 - Support for European Technology Platforms
 - ☐ Need for industry-led development of Visions and Strategic Research Agendas promoting growth/jobs
 - ☐ How best to mobilise & involve SMEs?
 - ☐ Encouraged the creation of 'Mirror' Platforms
- EATiP acts as an umbrella organisation, canvassing, refining, prioritising opinions





Observations: 2

- > EURASTIP is taking a grass roots up approach
 - ☐ Starting with the creation of National MSPs (i.e. mirror platforms)
 - Create confidence in and support for
 - Concept of the National MSPs
 - Consensus decisions on positions/strategies
 - Development of influence of the MSPs
 - ➤ Pro-active engagement of MSPs
 - ☐ All prepare for the final creation of EURASTIP
