Bursaries of up to €3000 are available per exchange (subject to eligibility criteria) to support international innovation and collaboration.

### INDUSTRY

- Facilitate new business opportunities and develop industrial partnerships
- Open to all stakeholders related to the sustainable aquaculture industry, from technicians to CEOs
- Exchange duration: minimum five working days

### RESEARCHERS

- Share knowledge and research experience
- Open to all researchers from both research institutes and industry, including technicians and senior researchers
- Exchange duration: minimum ten working days

### EDUCATORS

- Build capacity, maximise cooperation and develop strategic partnerships
- Open to aquaculture training providers at all levels, from vocational centres to universities
- Exchange duration: minimum ten working days
