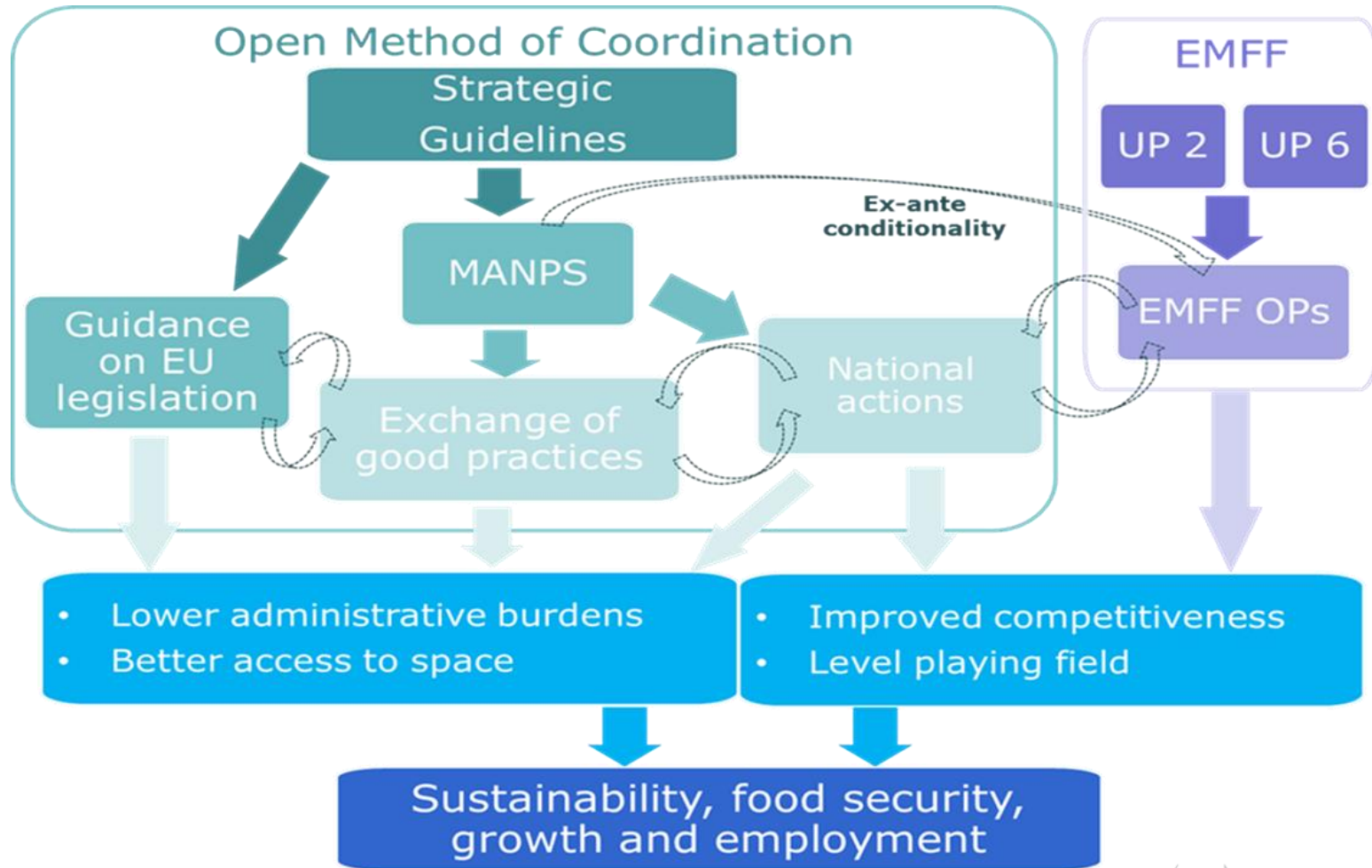

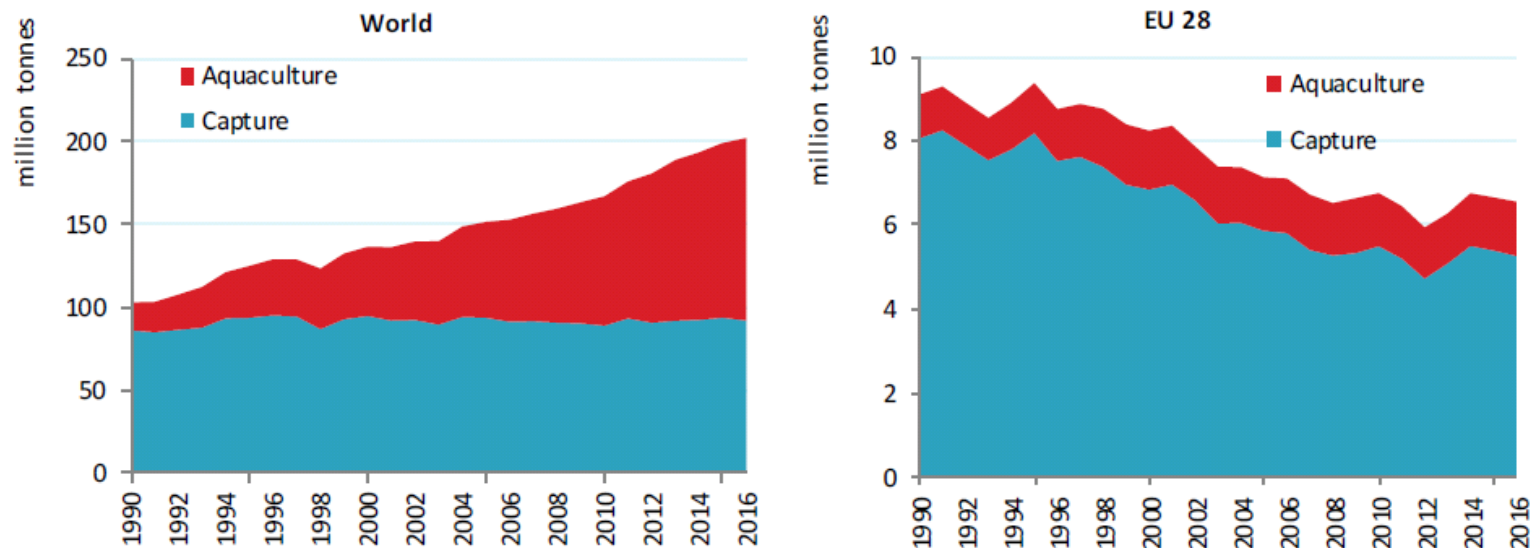


Figure 2.1: World and EU28 seafood production (capture and aquaculture): 1990-2016.

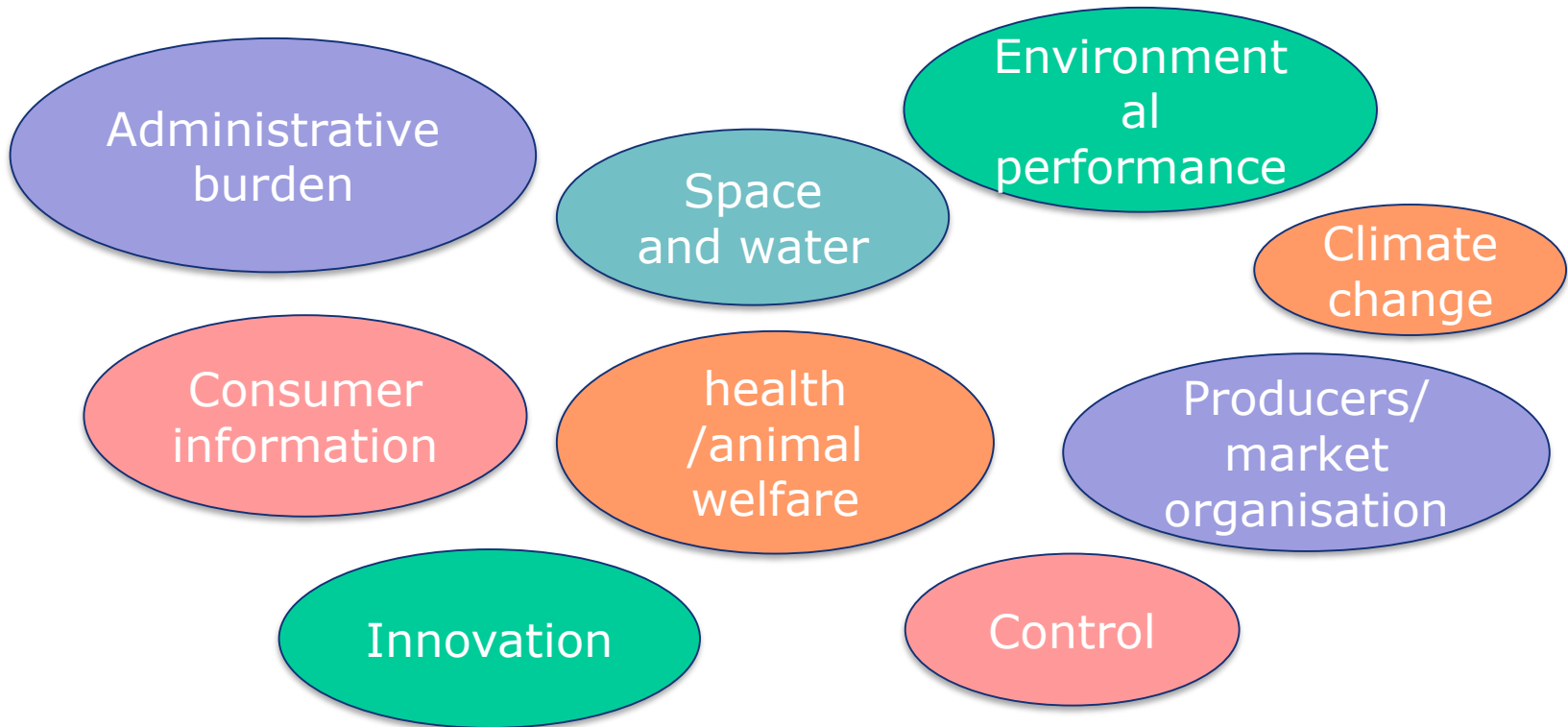
Main species # Farmed in the EU

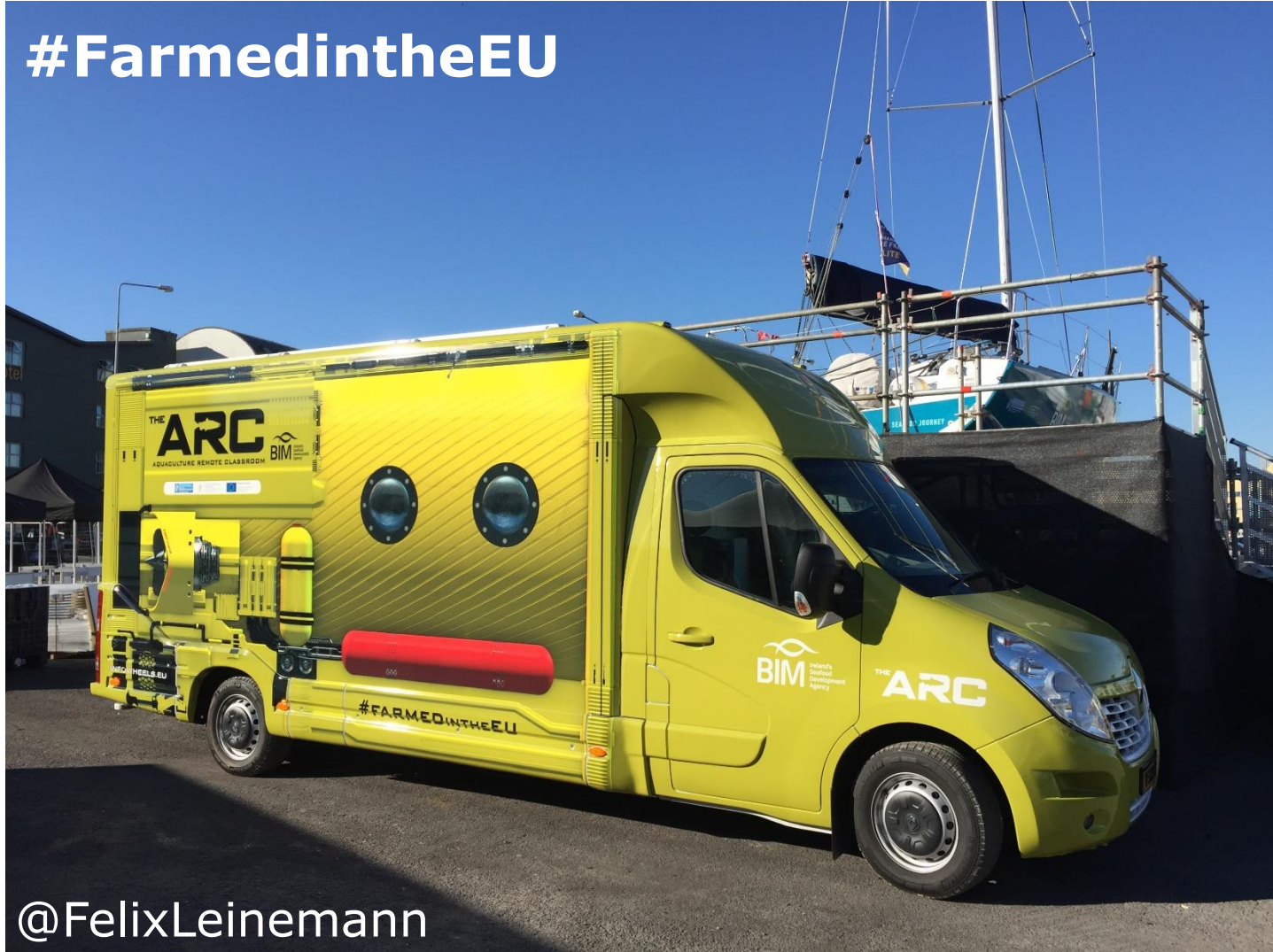
