

Missions



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R&I Missions

A mission is a portfolio of actions across disciplines intended to achieve a bold and inspirational and measurable goal within a set timeframe, with impact for society and policy making.

Missions will be **co-designed with Member States**, **stakeholders and citizens** and programmed within the Global Challenges and Industrial Competitiveness pillar

Mission areas: cancer, climate change, healthy oceans, climate-neutral cities and healthy soil and food.

Mission Board: Each mission board consists of 15 experts, including the chair. They will identify the first possible specific missions on the five areas by the end of 2019 with the support of a mission assembly.
